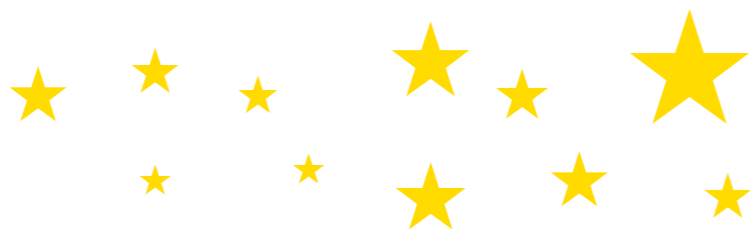

Femicides and the Establishment of a Central Action and Memorial Site at Frauenplatz in Munich for Feminist Movements and Remembrance

This event is a central part of the **Action Weeks Against Violence towards Women, Girls, Boys, and Non-binary People**, on the occasion of the **International Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women**.

So that we can all live as equals, self-determined, and free from violence.

The term "femicide" was coined internationally to describe fatal violence against women, girls, and those perceived as female, due to the attribution of "womanhood." This term underscores that these killings are not isolated incidents but a consequence of global patriarchal structures, misogyny, and gender-based hierarchies of power, control, and oppression.



To make visible the violence caused by societal inequality and power structures, we are calling for the establishment of a central action and memorial site in the heart of Munich.

Our call is for a permanent monument at Frauenplatz, Munich, which will not only make feminist and queer-feminist movements visible, but also serve as a reminder and anchor the ongoing fight against femicides at the core of the city's society.
